
WINTER WATER

Once common, native riparian areas are largely gone from our river valley today. At Rio Bosque Wetlands Park, we are working to bring wetland and riparian habitats back. Lack of water during the growing season makes this a challenging task.

Prolonged drought, as we've experienced in recent years, intensifies the challenge. Still, one area at Rio Bosque is showing progress. The well at the park's inlet keeps a 0.5-mile reach of the old river channel in the park consistently wet. Here, native riparian
